THE HERTFORDSHIRE (TEMPORARY CLOSING AND TEMPORARY WAITING RESTRICTIONS IN VARIOUS ROADS IN GREEN TYE, FURNEUX PELHAM AND BISHOPS STORTFORD) ORDER 2018

NOTICE is given that the Hertfordshire County Council intends to make an Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, to prohibit all traffic from using the following lengths of roads ("the Roads"), except for access and to prohibit all vehicles from waiting at any time on both sides of these lengths of Roads whilst works are in progress:-

1. that length of 3U42 (unnamed road), Green Tye from its junction with B1004 Great Hadham Road south eastwards and south westwards to its junction with Aerodrome Road, a distance of approximately 1085 metres.

An alternative route will be via B1004 Great Hadham Road and Aerodrome Road.

2. that length of C15 (unnamed road), Furneux Pelham from its junction with Barleycroft End north eastwards and south eastwards to its junction with Gravesend, a distance of approximately 581 metres.

An alternative route will be via Barleycroft End, The Street and C107 (unnamed road).

3. that length of Heath Row, Bishops Stortford from its westernmost junction with Parsonage Lane north westwards, north eastwards, south eastwards and south westwards to its easternmost junction with Manston Drive, a distance of approximately 1151 metres.

An alternative route will be via Parsonage Lane and Heath Row.

4. that length of Obrey Way, Bishops Stortford from its junction with the A1184 St James Way roundabout north eastwards to its junction with the Whittington Way/Friedberg Avenue roundabout, a distance of approximately 640 metres.

An alternative route will be via A1184 St James Way, B1383 Thorley Street and Whittington Way.

5. that length of Farnham Road, Bishops Stortford from a point 60 metres north west of its junction with B1004 Rye Street north westwards and south westwards for a distance of approximately 944 metres.

An alternative route will be via B1004 Rye Street, Hazelend Road, Hazel End, Mill Hill and Farnham Road.

6. that length of Gipsy Lane, Bishops Stortford from its junction with Hazelend Road north eastwards for a distance of approximately 546 metres.

An alternative route will be via Hazelend Road, B1004 Michaels Road, B1383 Stansted Road and Gipsy Lane.

7. that length of Scott Road, Bishops Stortford from its junction with the Apton Road/ Jervis Road roundabout south westwards and south eastwards to its junction with Piggotts Way, a distance of approximately 651 metres.

An alternative route will be via Apton Road, B1529 (Potter Street/Market Street), B1004 (High Street/Windhill/Great Hadham Road), Villiers Sur Marne Avenue, Thorley Lane Busway and Piggotts Way

or via Apton Road, B1529 (Potter Street/South Street), Havers Lane, Elizabeth Road and Piggotts Way.

8. that length of Dane O'Coys Road, Bishops Stortford from its junction with Cricketfield Lane northwards, north westwards and north eastwards to its junction with Whitehall Road, a distance of approximately 1165 metres.

An alternative route will be via Cricketfield Lane, Barrells Down Road and Whitehall Road.

The Order is needed because works are proposed to be executed on or near the Roads.

If the Order is made, it shall come into force on 1 April 2018 for a period of up to 18 months. However, the restrictions specified shall only take effect at the times indicated by signs on or near the Roads.

A copy of the proposed Order may be inspected free of charge at County Hall, Hertford between the hours of 9.00am and 5.00pm (excluding weekends, bank and public holidays).
