THE HERTFORDSHIRE (TEMPORARY CLOSING OF FURNEUX PELHAM PUBLIC FOOTPATH NO.004) ORDER 2018

NOTICE is given that the Hertfordshire County Council intends to make an Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, to prohibit all pedestrians from using Furneux Pelham Public Footpath No.004 from its junction with The Street northwards and north eastwards for a distance of approximately 1841 metres (“the Public Footpath”).

There is no alternative route available for pedestrians when the works are being carried out. However pedestrian access to properties will be maintained whenever possible throughout the duration of the works.

The Order is needed because utility service installation works are proposed to be executed on or near the Public Footpath.

If the Order is made, it shall come into force on 29 October 2018 for a period of up to 6 months. However, the restrictions specified shall only take effect at the times indicated by signs on or near the Public Footpath.

A copy of the proposed Order may be inspected free of charge at County Hall, Hertford between the hours of 9.00am and 5.00pm (excluding weekends, bank and public holidays).
