THE HERTFORDSHIRE (TEMPORARY CLOSING OF VARIOUS ROADS IN FURNEUX PELHAM, STOCKING PELHAM AND MUCH HADHAM) ORDER 2018

NOTICE is given that the Hertfordshire County Council intends to make an Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, to prohibit all traffic from using the following lengths of roads ("the Roads"), except for access:-

1. that length of C35 (unnamed road), Furneux Pelham from its junction with The Causeway north eastwards to its junction with Barleycroft End, a distance of approximately 433 metres.

An alternative route will be via The Causeway, The Street and Barleycroft End.

2. that length of C15 (unnamed road), Stocking Pelham from its junction with Ginns Road north westwards, south westwards, north westwards and north eastwards to its junction with B1038 Pump Hill, a distance of approximately 2138 metres.

An alternative route will be via Ginns Road, Pelham Road, Berden Road, Stortford Road and B1038 (Pelham Road/unnamed road/Pump Hill).

3. that length of C107 (unnamed road), Furneux Pelham from its junction with Gravesend north eastwards to its junction with The Street, a distance of approximately 1227 metres.

An alternative route will be via C15 (unnamed road), Barleycroft End and The Street.

4. that length of Patient End, Furneux Pelham from its junction with The Causeway south westwards and north westwards to its junction with Braughing Road, a distance of approximately 564 metres.

An alternative route will be via The Causeway, The Street, Worsted Lane, B1368 (unnamed road/Dassels Hill/Dassels/Hay Street/Green End), Ford Street, The Street, Pelham Road and Braughing Road.

5. that length of The Street, Furneux Pelham from its junction with The Wash south westwards and north westwards for a distance of approximately 2978 metres.

An alternative route will be via C107 (unnamed road), C15 (unnamed road), C35 (unnamed road), Patient End, Braughing Road, Pelham Road, The Street, Ford Street, B1368 (Green End/Hay Street/Dassels/Dassels Hill/unnamed road), Worsted Lane and The Street.

6. that length of Violets Lane, Furneux Pelham from its junction with The Street north eastwards and north westwards for a distance of approximately 1636 metres.

There is no alternative route available for vehicles when the works are being carried out. However vehicular access to properties in this road will be maintained whenever possible throughout the duration of the works.

7. that length of Ginns Road, Stocking Pelham from its junction with The Wash north eastwards to its junction with C15 (unnamed road), a distance of approximately 1093 metres.

An alternative route will be via The Wash, The Street, Worsted Lane, B1368 (unnamed road), B1038 (unnamed road/Conduit Lane/Pump Hill) and C15 (unnamed road).

8. that length of The Wash, Stocking Pelham from its junction with The Street north eastwards to its junction with Ginns Road, a distance of approximately 360 metres.

An alternative route will be via The Street, Worsted Lane, B1368 (unnamed road), B1038 (unnamed road/Conduit Lane/Pump Hill), C15 (unnamed road and Ginns Road).

9. that length of Barleycroft End, Furneux Pelham from its junction with The Street south eastwards to its junction with C15 (unnamed road), a distance of approximately 561 metres.

An alternative route will be via The Street, C107 (unnamed road) and C15 (unnamed road).

10. that length of East End, Furneux Pelham from its junction with The Street south eastwards, southwards and south eastwards for a distance of approximately 1575 metres.

An alternative route will be via The Street, The Wash, Ginns Road, Pelham Road, Berden Road, Manuden Road and Maggots End.

11. that length of Kettle Green Road, Much Hadham from its junction with B1004 Widford Road westwards, south westwards and north westwards to its junction with Cold Christmas Lane, a distance of approximately 3107 metres.

An alternative route will be via B1004 (Widford Road/Medcalf Hill/High Street/Ware Road/Widbury Hill/Star Street), A1170 (High Street/Baldock Street/Wadesmill Road), Cambridge Road and Cold Christmas Lane.

12. that length of Malting Lane, Much Hadham from its junction with B1004 Tower Hill south eastwards and north eastwards to its junction with Danebridge Road, a distance of approximately 373 metres.

An alternative route will be via B1004 (Tower Hill/High Street) and Oudle Lane.

The Order is needed because utility service installation works are proposed to be executed on or near the Roads.

If the Order is made, it shall come into force on 29 October 2018 for a period of up to 18 months. However, the restrictions specified shall only take effect at the times indicated by signs on or near the Roads.

A copy of the proposed Order may be inspected free of charge at County Hall, Hertford between the hours of 9.00am and 5.00pm (excluding weekends, bank and public holidays).
