THE HERTFORDSHIRE (TEMPORARY CLOSING OF GINNS ROAD, STOCKING PELHAM AND THE CAUSEWAY, FURNEUX PELHAM) ORDER 2018

NOTICE is given that the Hertfordshire County Council intends to make an Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, to prohibit all traffic from using the following lengths of roads ("the Roads"), except for access:-

1. that length of Ginns Road, Stocking Pelham from its junction with C15 (unnamed road) eastwards and north eastwards for a distance of approximately 543 metres.

An alternative route will be via Ginns Road, The Wash, The Street, Worsted Lane, B1368 (unnamed road), B1038 (unnamed road/Conduit Lane/Pump Hill/unnamed road/Pelham Road), Stortford Road, Berden Road and Pelham Road.

2. that length of The Causeway, Furneux Pelham from its junction with The Street south westwards and south eastwards to its junction with Patient End, a distance of approximately 787 metres.

An alternative route will be via The Street, Barleycroft End and C35 (unnamed road).

The Order is needed because the installation of fibre optic cables is proposed to be executed on or near the Roads.

If the Order is made, it shall come into force on 11 December 2018 for a period of up to 18 months. However, the restrictions specified shall only take effect at the times indicated by signs on or near the Roads.

A copy of the proposed Order may be inspected free of charge at County Hall, Hertford between the hours of 9.00am and 5.00pm (excluding weekends, bank and public holidays).
