# Minutes

## **1) Parishioner feedback**

Opportunity given to parishioners to provide feedback to the Parish Council. The feedback received is summarised below (taken from post-it notes recorded on) and is in no particular order:

- Parish Council to have a higher profile in village - meet more often, more timely communication
- Roads - 30 mile speed limit through the village
- 30 mile sign on Hormead Road to be re-located further out of the village
- Lobby for a 30 mph limit around the whole village given the numbers of cyclists, walkers, horse riders (riding school) & increase in housing
- How can the PC assist with the pot-hole issues on Whitebarns Lane?
- Whitebarns Lane - repairs, adoption by Council
- Whitebarns Lane - pot-holes - road up from The Street to the private road
- Pot-holes
- Parking for school - particularly during pick up (drop-off solution lessens issue)
- Litter and flytipping
- Proper broadband speed
- Branches past sewerage works
- Playground (x2)
- Village security cameras
- Investigate having the football field classed as a community asset to forestall building on it
- Replace sign where ford/river divides that was provided 6 or so years ago
- Coffee morning in Village Hall
- Community self help group established
- Pallets - plastic waste from shredding gets into fields, gardens etc
- Pallet business - too much noise, also working outside designated hours (06:45), dust in eyes when you walk by
- Investigate expanding the PC website to include village organisations e.g. contact details, programmes (what's on). Make as a village website. See Braughing one
- Parish Council links to our community websites
